

The privacy policy describes the rules by which we process information about you, including personal data and cookies.

1. General information

- This policy applies to the Website operating under the url address: www.textilco.pl
- The website operator is: TEXTILCO Marek Stasio Łanowa 15/21, 91-103 Łódź • The operator's e-mail address is: textilco@textilco.pl
- The Operator is the Controller of your personal data in relation to the data provided voluntarily on the Website.
- The Website uses personal data for the following purposes:
 - Handling of queries through the form
 - Presentation of the offer or information
 - Running the newsletter
- The Website collects limited information about users and their behaviour:
 1. Data entered voluntarily in the forms which are entered into the Operator's systems.
 2. Data that the user's browser provides to our website: IP address, type of browser, browser language, date and time of visit
 3. Cookies.

We use these data to improve our website and better understand user behaviour.

2. Selected

- Places where personal data are entered are protected at the transmission layer (SSL certificate). Thanks to this, personal data entered on the Website are encrypted on the user's computer and can be read only on the target server.

3. Your rights and additional information on how to use the data

- In some situations, the Controller has the right to transfer your personal data to other recipients, if it is necessary to perform the contract concluded with you or to fulfil the Controller's obligations. This applies to such groups of recipients as:

- couriers
 - postal operators
 - insurers
 - law firms and debt collectors
 - banks
 - public authorities
 - authorised employees and associates who use data to achieve the purpose of the Website
- Your personal data are processed by the Controller no longer than it is necessary to perform the related activities specified in separate regulations (e.g. on accounting). With regard to marketing data, the data will not be processed for more than 3 years.
 - You have the right to request the Controller to:
 - provide access to your personal data,
 - rectify,
 - delete,

- restrict the processing of,
 - and transfer your data.

- You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in order to exercise legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, including profiling, while the right to object cannot be exercised if there are valid legitimate grounds for processing, interests overriding your rights and freedoms, in particular the right to determine, assert, or defend claims.
 - The Controller's actions may be appealed to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.
 - Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to operate the Website.
 - Shared personal data may be subject to profiling.
 - Personal data are not transferred to third countries within the meaning of the regulations on the protection of personal data. This means that we do not send them outside the European Union.

4. Information in the forms

- The data provided in the form are processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a specific form, e.g. in order to process a service request, answer a query or business contact.

5. Important marketing techniques

- The operator uses statistical analysis of website traffic through Google Analytics (Google Inc. based in the USA). The operator does not transfer personal data to the operator of this Website, but only anonymised information. The Website uses cookies on the user's end device. In terms of information about user preferences collected by the Google advertising network,

the user can view and edit information derived from cookies using the tool:

6. Information about cookie files

- The website uses cookies.
- Cookies are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the User's end device and are intended for using the Website's pages. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, their storage time on the end device and a unique number.
- The entity placing the cookies on the User's end device and accessing them is the Website Operator.
- Cookies are used to achieve the goals set out above in the 'Important marketing techniques' section.
- The Website uses two basic types of cookies: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until they log out, leave the Website or turn off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
- Browsing software (web browser) usually by default enables storing cookies on the User's end device. Website Users can change the settings in this area. The web browser allows you to delete cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. Detailed information on this subject is provided in the help file or documentation of the web browser.
- Cookies placed on the User's end device may also be used by entities working closely with the Website Operator, in particular the following companies: Google (Google Inc. with its registered office in the USA).

- Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.

7. Managing cookie files - how to give and withdraw consent in practice?

- If the user does not want to receive cookies, they can change the browser settings. The browser's "Help" function should provide information on controlling how cookies are used. We reserve that disabling cookies may hinder, and in extreme cases may prevent you from using all the functionalities of websites.
